

**QUAIL CROSSING BOARD RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO  
THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF QUAIL CROSSING RESIDENTIAL  
ASSOCIATION, INC.**

*WHEREAS, the growing, cultivation, or possession of marijuana is a federal offense;*

At a board meeting held on JUNE 15, 2011 properly convened and a quorum present, after motion, seconded, and approved, it was adopted and resolved that the RULES AND REGULATIONS OF QUAIL CROSSING RESIDENTIAL ASSOCIATION, INC., signed November 15, 2006, as amended, shall be amended as follows:

Section 4. **NUISANCES** is amended in its entirety to state the following:

**4. NUISANCES**

No noxious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any Lot or any part of the community, nor shall anything be done or maintained thereon which shall become an annoyance or nuisance to any other Lot Owner or resident or detract from the value of the Planned Community as an attractive residential community. Habitually barking, howling, or yelping dogs or cats and unremoved excrement therefrom shall be deemed to be a nuisance. No activity shall be conducted on any part of the community which is, or might be, unsafe, unsightly, unhealthy or hazardous to any person. The growing, cultivation, or possession of marijuana shall be deemed a nuisance and an activity which is, or might be, unsafe, unsightly, unhealthy or hazardous to any person.
